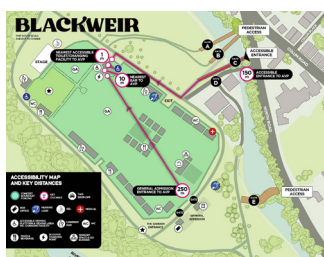

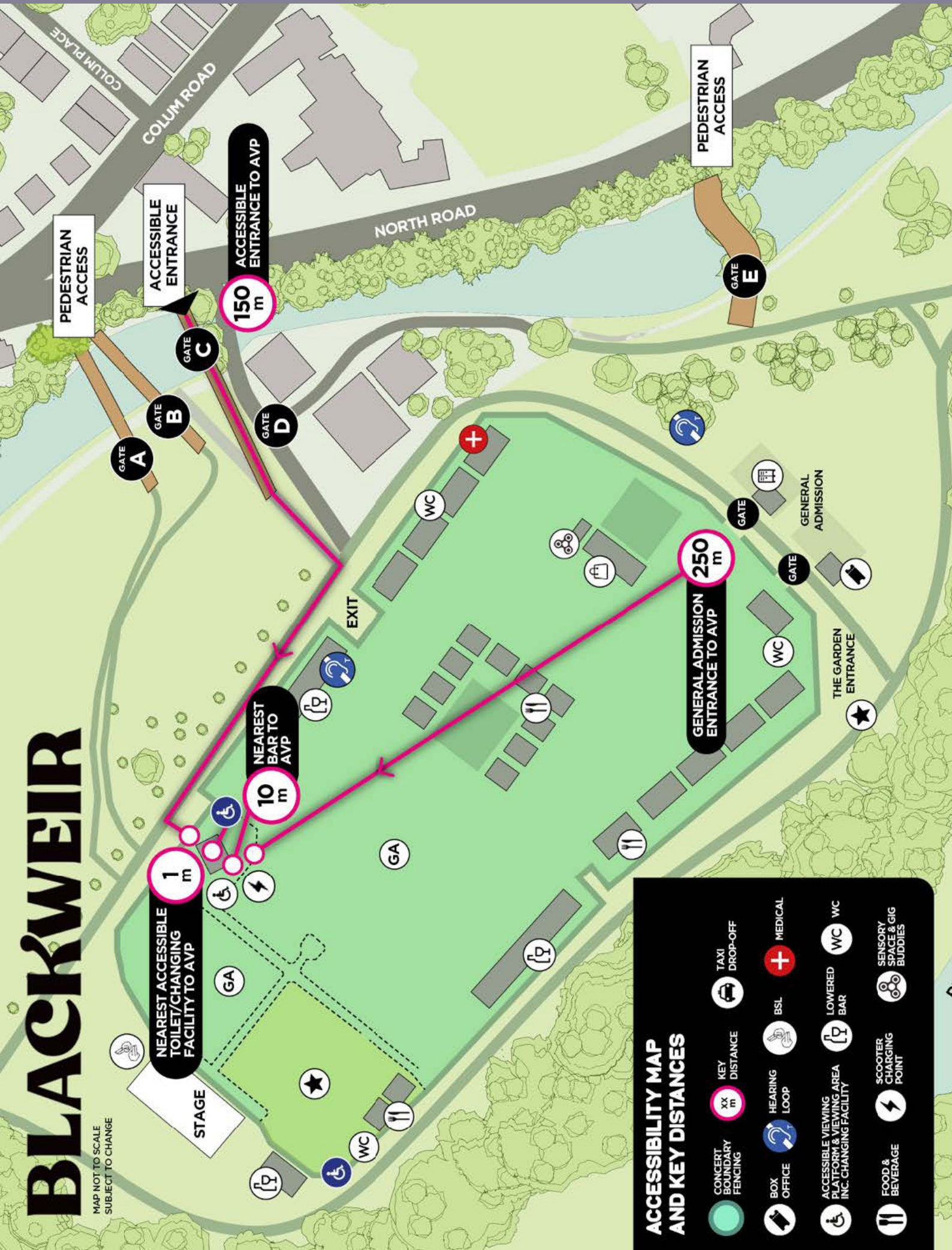

Site info



This is an outdoor concert. Think about what you will wear if the weather changes. It may get colder in the evening, so bring a jacket. Also, think about footwear.



Blackweir takes place at **Blackweir Fields**. This is a large grass site. It is quite flat but can be uneven. The ground may also be muddy or dusty.



There is grass in the main area. But with a **trackway** from the **accessible entrance** to the **accessible viewing area**.

A **trackway** is a path that has been put in for the festival.



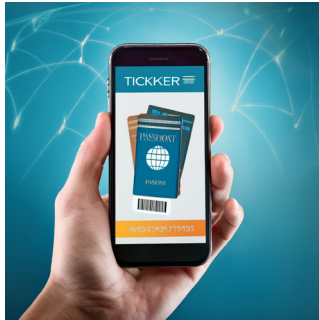

When you arrive



Accessible ticket holders have their own entrance. See the map on page 6 to find where the **accessible entrance** is.

Event staff can support you if you need help to get in.



When you arrive you will need to show your **digital ticket**. You then need to have a security bag check. We check everyone's bags for safety.



You will then be given an **accessibility wristband**, and be directed to the **accessible viewing platform**. Staff will be around to help. There will be clear signs too.



The **box office** is where tickets are kept. It can be found at the **general admission entrance**. This is 250 meters from the **accessible area**. The box office is open from 3.00pm until 9.00pm.



As the box office is far from the **accessible entrance**, a staff member will be at the **accessible entrance** to support you if you need it.

Travel information



There is no on-site parking available. The nearest public parking is at the Civic Centre. This is about 500 meters from the **accessible entrance**.



The route from the nearest car park to Blackweir has a pavement with kerbs. There are a few benches along the way to rest if needed.



There may not be enough parking spaces. It might be helpful to arrive early. Other car parks are also available. You can find out more [here](#)

Bus

The closest train stations to the shows are Cardiff Central and Cardiff Queen Street station.



Cardiff Central Train Station is half a mile away.

Cardiff Queen Street Train Station is a little further. It is just under 1 mile.

Useful things on site

Accessible Toilets



Accessible toilets can be found across the site. Please see the site map on page 6.

Each set of toilet blocks has an **accessible toilet**. There are also **accessible toilets** available in the **accessible area**.

Accessible viewing platform



The **accessible viewing platform** is available for customers with an **accessible ticket** plus their companion.

It is a raised platform with a good view of the stage. Please see the map on page 6.

Charging



There will be charging points for mobility scooters, and electric wheelchairs at the **accessible viewing platform**.



Hearing Loops

There are **portable hearing loops** available at the main bar, box office and info point. Please see the map on page 6.

Hearing aids need to be switched to the 'T' setting. Please look for the **Hearing Loop sign** to find the correct area for it to work.



British Sign Language Interpreters (BSL)

We will be providing BSL interpreters for all Blackweir 2025 concerts.



Deaf

Deaf and Hard of Hearing ticket holders can access the **accessible viewing platform** or **general admission area**. The BSL interpreter is positioned on the right side of the stage.

Sensory zone



Gig Buddies Cymru are providing a Calm Area at Blackweir. It will be in the main arena near the general admission entrance. See the site map on page 6 to see where it is.



This space is for people who may need a quiet, supportive place.



The space has special lighting, seating and other equipment.

Medication



Medication is allowed on site if these rules are followed: They must be in their original packaging, with the prescription label clearly visible.



If it is not clear, please contact us [here](#) to arrange an approval letter.



Make sure you bring only the amount you need for the event. Please keep it safe with you at all times.



Medication may be checked at entry points. So please make sure you follow the rules above.

Accessible bar lanes



There are lowered bar counters, accessible lanes, and large print menus at most bars.



If a lowered bar counter is not possible, a member of staff can come around from the bar to take your order and help support you.

Food Traders



All food traders will have large print menus and you will not have to wait in long queues if you have support needs. There will be clear signs in place at each stall.



If a lowered bar counter is not possible, a member of staff can come around from the bar to take your order and help support you.

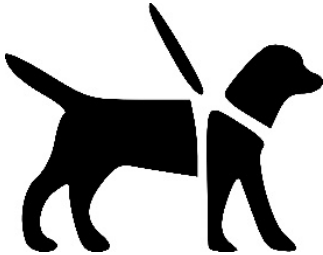


There are medical and welfare services available. Please ask a member of security to direct you to them if you need them.



Accessible Events specialise in **accessibility** at large events. They will manage the **accessible area** and support you if you need them.

Assistance Dogs



Assistance dogs are allowed on site. If you need to bring a registered assistance dog, please contact access@depotcardiff.com

Rules about the Accessible Viewing Platform



- The **Accessible Viewing Platform** is for wheelchair users and ticket holders with other access needs.



- Only these ticket holders and their **Essential Companion** may access the **Accessible Viewing Platform**.



- Access will be controlled with a wristband system.



- The **Accessible Viewing Platform** includes ramped access, wheelchair-accessible toilets nearby, and Charging Points.



- The **Accessible Viewing Platforms** are not covered; customers should think about the weather conditions.



- Smoking, including e-cigarettes and vapes, is not allowed.
- Staff and security can ask any customer to leave the Platform if behaving badly.
